## MASTER OF ARTS – ANTHROPOLOGY SOCIOCULTURAL SPECIALIZATION (Plan II - Exam) For Students Entering AY 2025-26

In addition to departmental requirements, candidates for graduate degrees must fulfill University requirements as described in the "Graduate Education" section of the UCSB General Catalog.

The M.A. in Anthropology, Sociocultural Specialization, is viewed as an integral part of preparation for the doctorate; students apply to both programs. Students intending to pursue only an M.A. degree in Sociocultural Anthropology will not be accepted into the graduate program.

Students must complete a minimum of **36.0 units** for the master's degree, 24 of which must be from the graduate series in Anthropology. Students in the M.A./Ph.D. program must first complete all of the M.A. requirements before continuing toward the doctorate. The time-to-degree for the M.A. is two years. These courses must be passed with a grade of B or better, with the exception of the Proseminar Requirements which must be passed satisfactorily.
